Clergy: Lord, we celebrate this Holy Week by tracing Your steps from Palm Sunday to Resurrection Sunday. Amid the waving of palms and the spreading of garments, you rode into Jerusalem. Your triumphant entry into the city marked the beginning of our redemption through Your atoning work on the cross.

The Saints: O blessed Savior, we thank You for our eternal redemption through Your obedience to the Father.

Clergy: Lord, on that Monday, You rebuked and confronted unrighteousness by cleansing the temple.

The Saints: O Holy and Righteous One, we thank You for our eternal redemption through the laying down of Your Holy and precious life.

Clergy: Lord, on Tuesday and Wednesday, You proclaimed that when You are lifted up from the earth, you will draw all people to You.

The Saints: Lord Jesus, we thank You for our eternal redemption through the shedding of Your blood, poured out as a sacrifice for our sins.

Clergy: Lord, on Thursday, You celebrated the Passover and instituted the Ordinance that has become our Eucharist, our Meal of Thanksgiving, our Holy Supper...our Communion Meal. You washed the disciples' feet, promised the Holy Spirit, and healed the ear of Malchus, because of Your great love for humanity.

The Saints: O Great Healer, we thank you for our eternal redemption through Your great love for sinners displayed by Your willingness to die at the hands of Your creation, who You came to save.

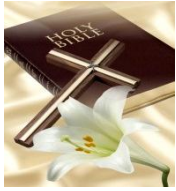
